



## John H. Boner Community Center and 2012 Indianapolis Super Bowl Host Committee Announce Unprecedented Investment in Near Eastside

Indianapolis - The John H. Boner Community Center and the 2012 Indianapolis Super Bowl Host Committee announced an unprecedented \$7 million social investment from State Farm Insurance today designed to support the Near Eastside's Quality of Life plan and the 2012 Indianapolis Super Bowl Host Committee's Legacy Project.
