



## Frank Supovitz Luncheon

On June 9th 2009 Senior Vice President of Events for the NFL spoke with Indianapolis City and political leaders about plans for the 2012 Super Bowl. He discussed both what the NFL expected from the city and what the city could expect in return. The Super Bowl brings thousands of people to the city and Indianapolis leaders were told what they should expect to see in the next two and a half years in preparation for that.
